APPRENTICESHIP ILLINOIS COMMITTEE

The Apprenticeship Illinois Committee (AIC) is one of four content-focused Illinois Workforce Innovation Board (IWIB) committees.

The chair, Daniel Serota, is a member of the IWIB.

Other members of this committee do not have to be appointed by the Governor and can be invited by the chair.

There are typically 20 voting members of this committee.

The committee focuses on providing leadership on:

- 1. Expanding apprenticeships geographically and to new industries.
- 2. Increasing diversity, equity, and inclusion in apprenticeship.
- 3. Formalizing statewide apprenticeship coordination across partnering state agencies.
- 4. Growing statewide capacity to provide apprenticeship opportunities to career seekers and businesses.



AIC MARKETING WORKGROUP (AIC MWG)

- Educate various stakeholders and raise awareness on the benefits of apprenticeships and work-based learning programs.
- Organize events and marketing around National Apprenticeship Week.






Step-by-step instructions are available.

Required Fields:

- Event Title
- Event Type
- Start and End Date/Time
 - Select "All Day" if there is no time (ex. Social Media Campaign)
 - Select "Repeat Scheduled Event" to add an event series as Daily, Weekly, or Specific Days.
- Location
 - URL or physical address.
- Description
- Audience
 - Select "Apprenticeship."
- Series
 - Select "Apprenticeship Week" to display on the Apprenticeship Illinois Event Calendar!
- Click "Add Event."


